In the first session, which was held at the international school in Frankfurt, a total of 72 students and their parents took part.

The informative session at the International School of Düsseldorf had 48 participants, many of whom are considering enrollment at a Japanese university. Finally, 42 Japanese students and parents joined our last informative session at the International School of Amsterdam.
