November 23, 2014, Bern, Switzerland: Informative Event on Studying in Japan



The “Experience Japan in Bern 2014,” held by the University of Bern, was one of the events organized to celebrate the 150th anniversary of the Japan–Switzerland diplomatic relationship. Tsukuba, Waseda University, the Embassy of Japan, the EPF Lausanne, and many other institutions came and promoted studying in Japan to the young visitors.

After all of the participating universities were introduced with short presentations by their representatives, a round table session was held with students who had already studied in Japan. About 30 young students visited our booth, many of whom have showed great interest in studying in Tsukuba.
